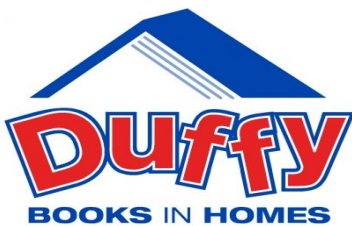
SKIDS School Holiday Programme
