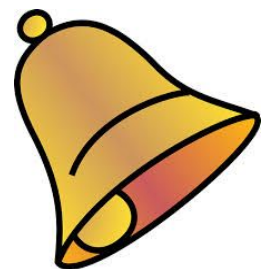
We will be running another workshop next term so please keep an eye out for dates in the school newsletters or call the school main office to find out more information.

School starts at 8:55 am in the morning and finishes at 2:55 am in the afternoon. On average we are finding over 50 children arriving after 9:00 am everyday. This is highly disruptive for the teachers and classes as instructions have to be repeated and the interruption affects everyone. Please try to ensure that students arrive at school on time. We appreciate that delays happen from time to time, but this has become a regular occurrence for a large number of students.
