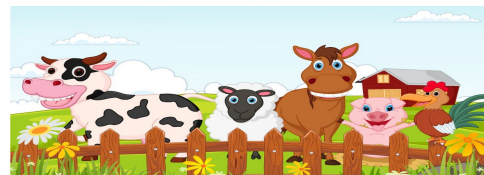
Reading Together Workshops
