Year 5 and 6 School Camp

As it is slowly getting colder, please ensure your child comes to school wearing their school jumper. We have a limited number of second hand jumpers available at the community centre. All items cost \$5.00 and can be paid at the school office.

Driving Around School Grounds and Pedestrian Crossing

There has been an increase in the number of parents driving into the school car park area or stopping in front of the gate to drop off or collect their children. The congestion this creates is a hazard and safety issue waiting for an accident to happen.

Please do the right thing and keep all of our students safe.

DO NOT drive in the car park or park in front of the gate, find a safe area to park and encourage your children to use the pedestrian crossing. We have trained Road Patrollers at the pedestrian crossing everyday to help get your children to and from school safely.



School Hours

It is concerning how many students are late to school each day. Please ensure that children arrive at school before school starts at 8.55 am. Students cause disruption in class when arriving late and also miss out on valuable learning time.



School finishes at 2.55pm and we are regularly seeing a lot of children still waiting to be picked up after 3.30pm. We do try to supervise these children but often have meetings after school. Please collect your children on time as children get unsettled and upset when they are collected late.

Mana Health Nurses in School



Just a reminder to students and families that we are in the school everyday for Health checks. This includes sore throats, skin sores, ear health etc. Please encourage your child to have their sore throats checked and swabbed. Your child just needs to inform their teacher and we will follow-up. We are rolling into the cold winter months where there is a significant increase in Strep throat infections.

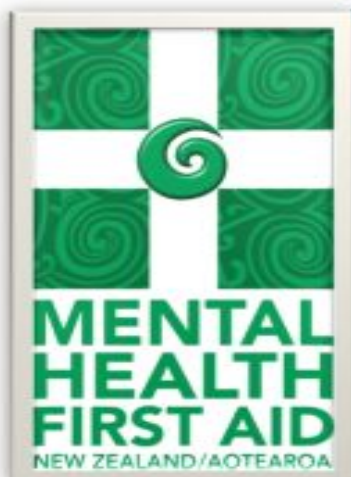
