<u>Travelwise</u>

We are now a Travelwise school! This means we will be working with Auckland Transport on road safety and making trips to school active, social and safe.

We encourage you to walk your children to and from school as it helps improve your child's fitness and health (and yours!), gets them to arrive at school awake, alert and ready to learn, keeps the school gate area clear of parked cars so it is safer for everyone, helps your child to become familiar with their community and to learn road sense skills and saves on petrol money.

Year 5 and 6 School Camp

Camp is now 4 weeks away. Full payment for camp must be paid 2 weeks before the students leave for camp. This means there are only 2 weeks left to make full payment for camp. If you have already paid a deposit, please make another payment towards your child's camp fees.



Through fundraising, the school has been able to reduce the total cost of camp this year by \$30.00 per student from \$160.00 now to \$130.00.
