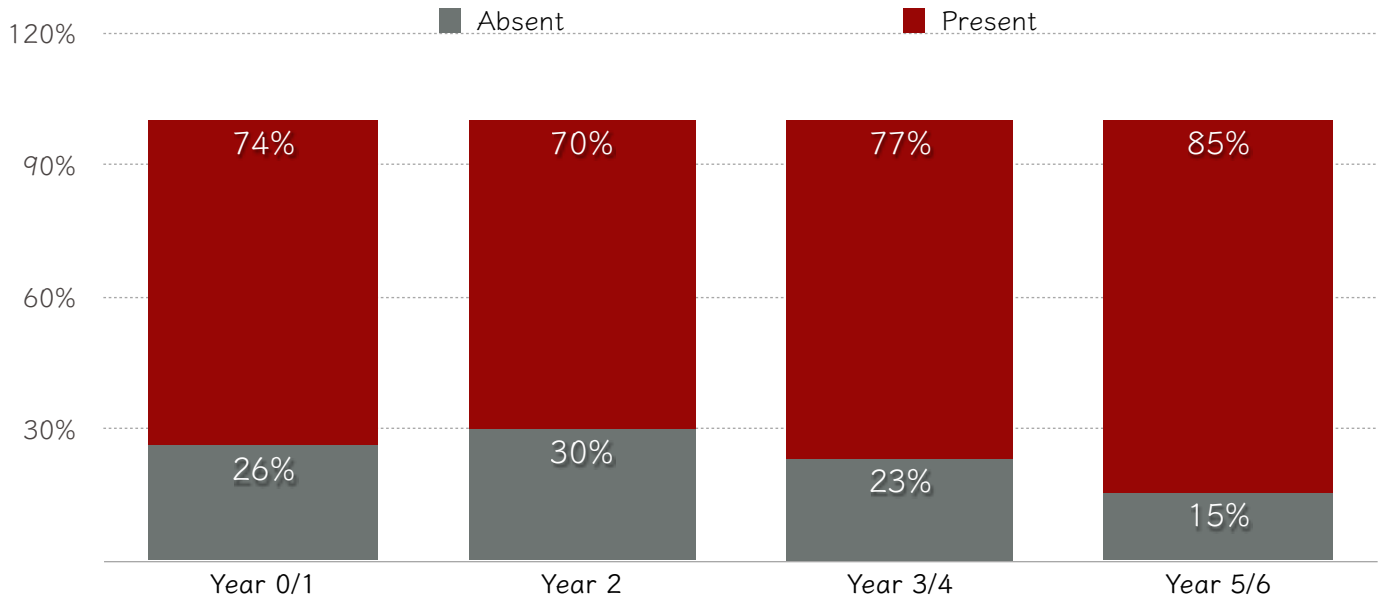
If you love to swim, you should come and play too.
