We do not open the gates until 8:00am and even then we still have many of our staff still on their way to school and cannot provide scheduled playground supervision until 8:30am.

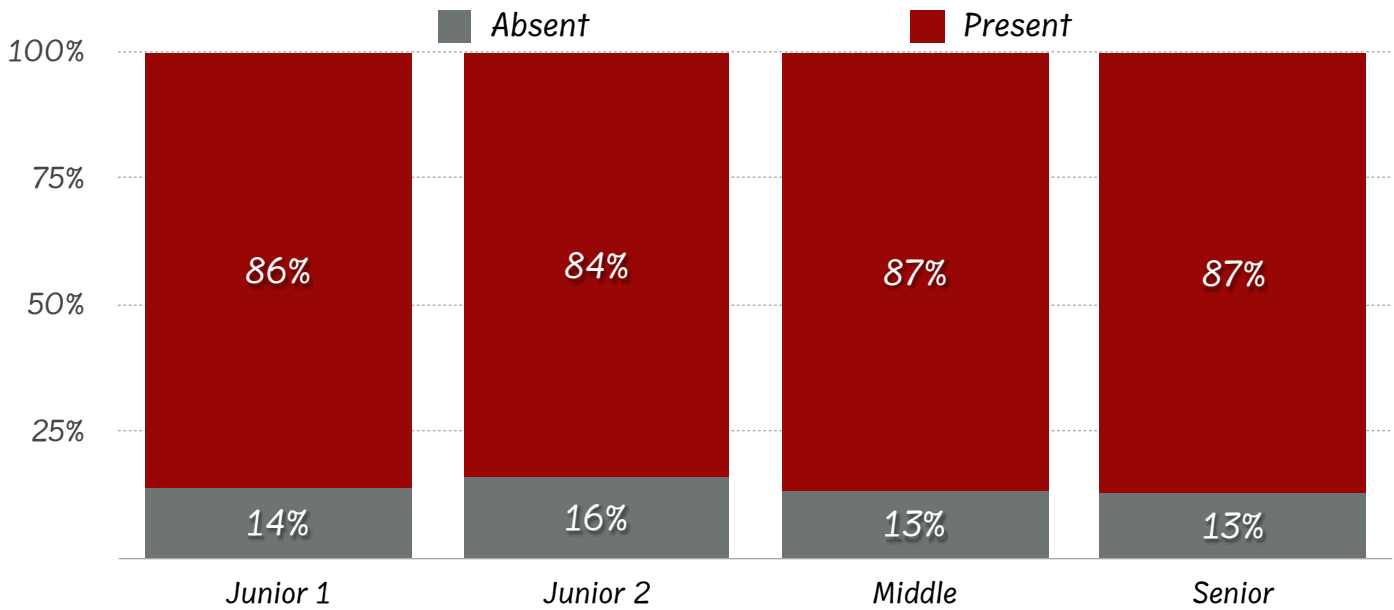
