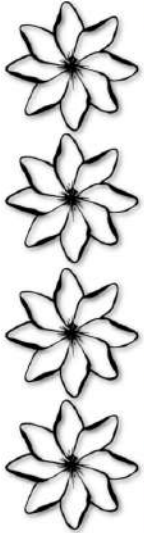

ENROLMENTS

At this stage, camp costs \$350.00 per student. This cost covers two overnight stays including glamping-style accommodation, catering and all equipment and activities. Camp fees must be paid in full by the end of this term, Term 3.

We understand that this cost for whanau is very high and for families with more than one child in the senior school, it could be an issue. We have applied for funding to help reduce the cost. We will keep you informed and refunds will be given if applicable.

If you have not paid anything towards your child's camp, a weekly payment of \$50.00 over 7 weeks, will have their camp fees paid in full by the end of this term, Term 3.

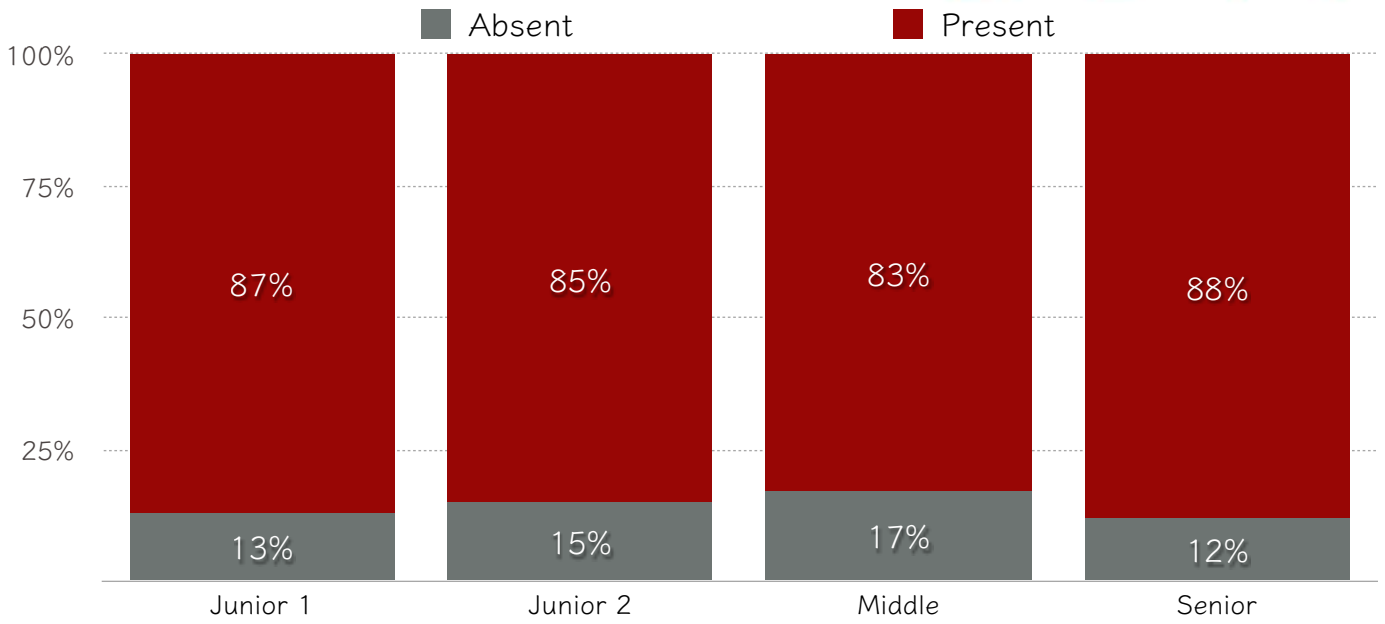
