CHANGES TO SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAMME

This week, the Government announced changes to Ka Ora, Ka Ako I Healthy School Lunches programme. These changes do not apply to our school lunches in 2025, but they will apply to us from Term 1, 2026. Next year and in 2026, our students will receive nutritious meals they know and love, helping them to learn and thrive at school.

From Term 1 2026, our lunches will be provided by the School Lunch Collective, led by Compass Group and supported by a number of food manufacturers and suppliers. These hot and cold meals will be delivered daily and will meet the same nutrition standards as our current lunches.



There are no changes for our ākonga with complex special dietary requirements. Their meals and additional funding will continue.

## PHOTOLIFE: CLASS, PORTRAITS & SIBLING PHOTOS

Class, Portraits and Sibling photos are ready to order. Yesterday, students were handed their Photolife Unique Codes to bring home. These forms will have the student's unique online photo access key. Parents can view photos, order and pay online directly to Photolife. Please note that the process for ordering photos has changed. ### ENROLMENTS FOR 2025

Our funding and staffing are mainly dependent on our school roll. The Ministry of Education has greatly reduced this for 2025 which means that we could lose 2-3 teachers, a lot of funding and have much less ability to provide the best that we can for your children.

At present, we have just ten students pre-enrolled through to 1<sup>st</sup> March 2025. We can apply for an increase to this estimate but do need to provide evidence of future enrolments. If you have children due to start school, please pre-enrol these children so that we can make a case to the Ministry of Education for more realistic funding and staffing.

Please come to the school office to collect an enrolment form. Take it home, complete the forms and return the forms to the office as soon as possible. Please bring a copy of your child's birth certificate or passport, proof of address, plunket book or updated immunisation

Protect your skin and eyes from the sun's damaging rays. Be SunSmart and wear a hat.




### CAUGHT BEING GOOD ASSEMBLY
